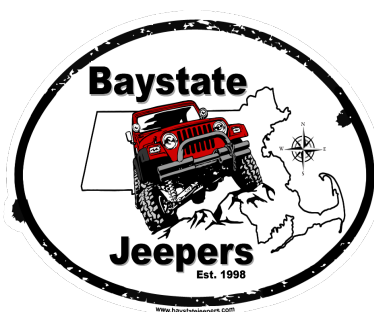

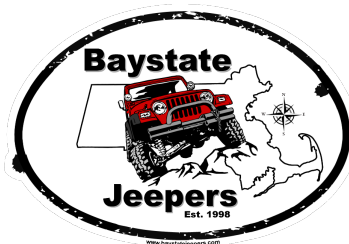
Baystate Jeepers camped and wheeled in Southern New Hampshire (October 19 - 20)

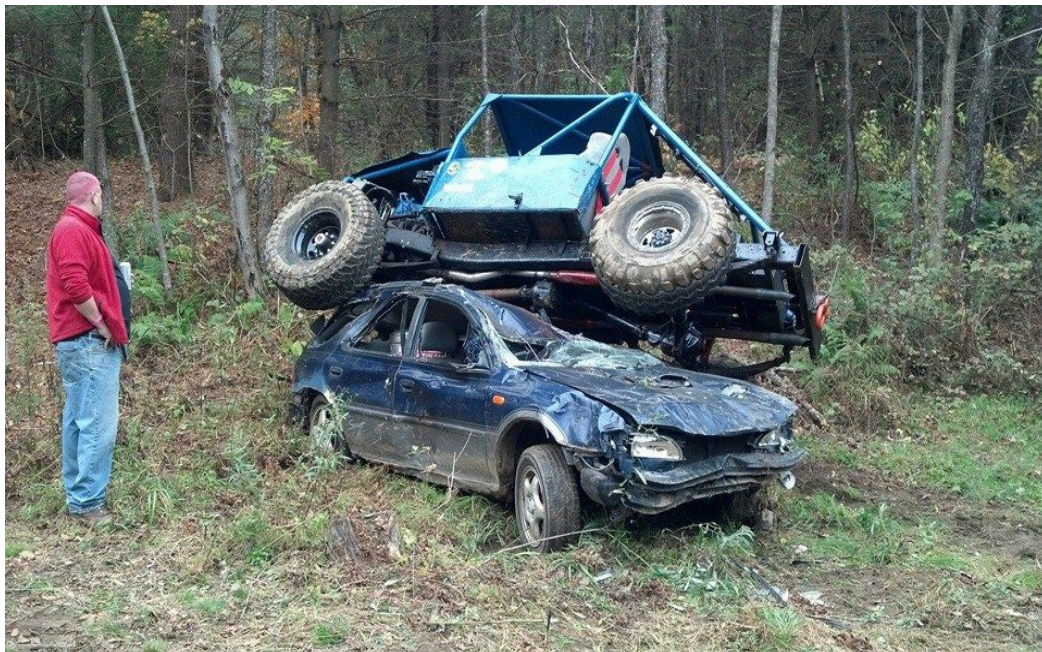

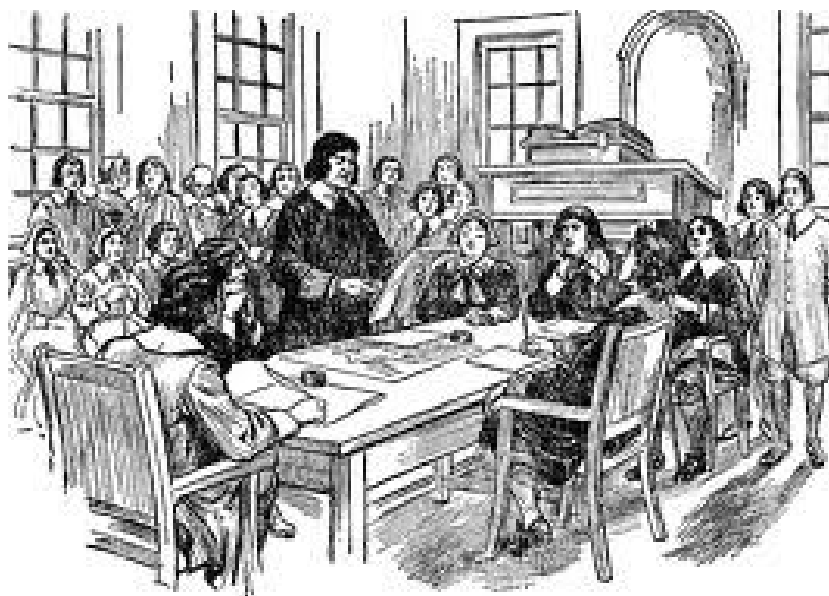

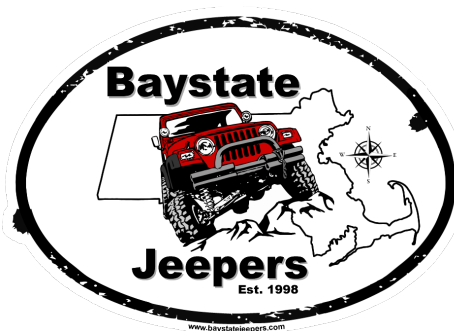


The annual BSJ potluck dinner and Gremlin Graveyard run is scheduled for November 23.
