Here's a pic from 2008, when Josh's 2003 TJ was sporting 34's, stock front fenders and an older bumper




October 2008: my first run with BSJ. After that day I was hooked on wheeling! I was wearing a silly grin for a month Running street tires, my only mod was tow hooks

Baystate Jeepers JEEP 101 (April 12)

Once again, BSJ member Ray Mond is letting the inmates run the asylum. Ray has agreed to host the annual Baystate Jeepers Jeep 101 event on his property. Are you new to off-roading, considering off-roading, or maybe just wondering what your Jeep can do? If so, then this event is for you. Jeep 101 is geared towards stock to slightly modified Jeeps and drivers who are new to off-roading





Topics covered at the J-101 include off-roading basics, trail gear (recommended and advanced), a Getting to Know Your Jeep session and other informative, interactive sessions. Take your Jeep on a log walk and finish the day with a trail ride on private property, with experienced guides and spotters to help along the way. You don't have to be a member of Baystate Jeepers to attend this event but you must register with Baystate Jeepers if you want to ask about attending. Held on private property, Baystate Jeepers reserves the right to limit the number of attendees. Jeep 101 is a family friendly event and like all BSJ events, alcohol is strictly prohibited on the trails





For this event, the safety equipment required for traditional Baystate Jeepers trail runs has been relaxed (for example, there's no need to bring a CB radio or fire extinguisher) but your Jeep should be in good working order, with a full size spare and an appropriate jack



It could go viral and before you know it, you're on Dancing with the Stars. Think of it. You. On DWTS!!!


And it all started with a hi-resolution picture of your rig. Wow. You're welcome.
